

THE CHILDREN'S PARLIAMENT - DO THE RIGHT THING LOCAL PROJECT

WHO TOOK PART

Following consultation and engagement with senior managers in our participating Local Authorities the Do the Right Thing Local projects engaged with a total of **770** participants.

Workshops for children and young people

- In Angus 300 children from P3 to S2 participated
- In Scottish Borders 413 children from 4 year olds in the Nursery to S1 pupils took part.

Workshops for professionals

- In Angus 38 professional colleagues working across 2 Learning Communities participated in workshops.
- In Scottish Borders 9 colleagues working in one Learning Community took part in workshops.

Drop in sessions for parents/carers

As part of the work in each community parents and carers were encouraged to drop in after school to find out more about what the children had been doing in the CP facilitated workshops. Whilst only a small number of parents did so (10 in all) conversations were wide ranging and parents identified some of the challenges they face when considering their responsibilities toward children whilst wanting them to experience freedom, fun and care. Parents left with information about the UNCRC.
