

Children's Parliament Investigates Bullying



Children's Parliament has been working with children to explore what it would look like to take a rights-based approach to bullying. The second phase of the **Children's Parliament Investigates Bullying** project involved 4 schools: **Abbeyhill Primary, Flora Stevenson's Primary, Granton Primary and St. John's RC Primary.**

Whole class workshops about children's human rights led to six children joining each school's team of Investigators. Children explored what needs to happen to make sure children are **healthy, happy** and **safe** at **school, at home** and **in the community.**
