How we grow and flourish

- We learn how to cycle.
- We learn how to play together.
- We make friends

Learning across subjects and in different ways

- Animals come into school. We learn how to take care of them and about who looks after them.
- Learning about growing food outside and healthy eating. We can play in the kitchen.
- We can dress up and be hairdressers, doctors or the police. We can meet these people.

The learning we do

- We have a construction corner where we can build Lego houses.
- We learn what can help us to stay calm.
- We learn how to care for our bodies: how to keep clean and wash, how to brush our teeth and how to keep ourselves safe.
- We learn maths through playing games and using pictures.
- We try out Polish and other languages.
- We have time to read our own choice of book. We have a reading corner in our classroom.
- We have a class calendar, so we can learn about the days of the week, seasons and special occasions.
- We sing and use microphones. We dance.
- We use rope to play outside. We can count when skipping. We play hopscotch to learn numbers.
- We have outdoor play equipment – like the wobbly bridge.
- Families come into school to play with us. We have toys in our classroom: Playdoh, cars and teddies.

The experience of being at school

- We learn by playing. We play with our friends. This could be in class, in the playground or after school.
- Our teachers are fun, make us laugh and give us cuddles.
- Having buddies (help from older years) makes us feel safe and happy
- There is a space in our classroom where we can go to feel warm, calm and safe.
- In our corridor, the toilets and sinks fit us, so we can learn how to use them.
