## Learning across subjects and in different ways

- We learn about food - how to plant, how to grow vegetables and how to feed your family from them. We learn how to cook (pancakes and pizza).
- We're given challenges. We do more team building, like making ginger-bread houses in teams

## The learning we do

- We learn about what is right and wrong.
